- 5. Agrees to adopt the Rates Remission and Postponement Policies.
- 6. Agrees to adopt the Resource Management Charging Policy (2015).
- 7. Agrees the following matters, which do not require any amendments to the 10 Year Plan 2015-2025, for implementation:
 - (i) Extension of the clean heating component of the Warm Greater Wellington programme to Wainuiomata, noting that this is revenue neutral, with consideration to be given to other areas in the region.

- (ii) The provision of \$30,000 per year from the Possum Predator Control Programme, subject to the Department of Conservation making a similar funding contribution, for the work of the Aorangi Restoration Trust in managing multi-species pests in South Wairarapa on land in private ownership surrounding the Aorangi Forest Park.
- (iii) Working with the Porirua City Council in further developing that Council's concept of a transit orientated development at the Porirua Railway Station.
- (iv) Maintain the travel demand management base programme and proposed rate funding levels, noting that the outcomes would be less than proposed in the consultation document.
- 8. Notes that a range of other issues identified by submitters but not directly related to the 10 Year Plan will be considered and reported back to Council at an appropriate time.
