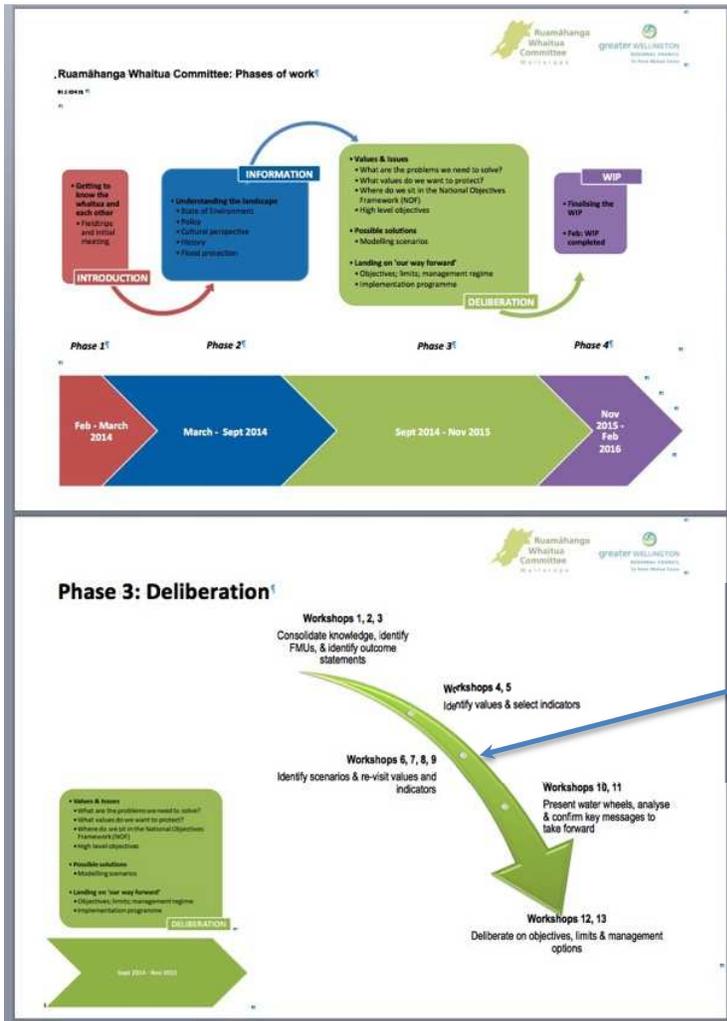



- How to utilise the information in our timeframe – and use it to set direction e.g. the issues for Maori coming from this.
- What does the land want to do; the water want to do?
- Use Caleb's information from 2011 – cultural health presentation and report
 - ACTION: Send out to Committee
 - See if we can we get Caleb to speak to it.
- What/how will cultural values be integrated into the WIP and whether or not there will be separation? 'Choc chip effect'

- Understanding what the important things are that connect Maori to the whole of the catchment.
